The Fund aims to provide long-term capital growth by investing in an ethically screened and diversified portfolio of global equities.

The fund seeks to invest in companies making a positive contribution to society and the environment, while avoiding investment in companies with damaging or unsustainable business practices.

#### Fund Strategy

- This fund may only invest in units of the Columbia Threadneedle (Lux) Responsible Global Equity SICAV
- The fund invests in companies screened against defined responsible and sustainable criteria, including exclusions on tobacco, alcohol, weapons, gambling, nuclear and pornography.
- The fund also requires companies to meet sector standards on social and environmental impacts. This fund is classified as ESG Article 8 under EU SFDR
